Skilled Nursing Facility/Special Treatment Program

Skilled Nursing Facilities/Special Treatment Programs provide behavioral intervention to residents with mental health issues in secure residential settings. Primary services include mental and physical health education, vocational coaching and life and social skills training. Additionally, residents participate in Crestwood's innovative Wellness Recovery Action Plan program (WRAP), Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT) and Dual-Diagnosis groups.

Our Special Treatment Program's Activities Department also provides our residents with leisure activities and outings with staff.
